I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by upgrading the definitive footpath (W 10/23) to a restricted byway along the route from Point B (at approximately SY 4100 9232) at the eastern end of definitive bridleways W 10/43 and W 10/44 and extending eastwards along definitive footpath W 10/23, to Point C (at approximately SY 4155 9245); and to add a Byway Open to All Traffic for the route extending eastwards from Point C (at approximately SY 4155 9245) through to Point D (at approximately SY 4168 9244), then north-eastwards to Point E (at approximately SY 4192 9260) at the end of the public road in Chideock in the Parish of Chideock.
