I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route starting from Point A (at approximately ST 7060 1655) at the eastern end of the public bridleway (N 51/38), and extending eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 7114 1658) at the northern end of the definitive bridleway (N 51/64) and onwards to Point C (at approximately ST 7142 1678) at the end of the public road by Manor Farm in Stalbridge Weston to be shown as byway open to all traffic, all in the parish of Stalbridge.
