- upgrading definitive footpath N 32/14 from Point A (at approximately ST 5907 1297) on the public road near Longford Bridge eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 6006 1310) to a restricted byway, and
- adding a restricted byway from Point B (at approximately ST 6006 1310) southwards along King's Road to Point C (at approximately to ST 6017 1295) where it joins the end of the public road in Thornford.

The application route is all in the parish of Thornford.
