I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by upgrading the bridleway N 11/8 from Point A (at approximately 6749 1296) to Point B (at approximately ST 6749 1277) to a restricted byway and adding a restricted byway from Point B (at approximately ST 6749 1277) to Point C (at approximately ST 6751 1251) at the northern end of the publically maintained road at Long Meadow, all in the parish of Folke. Historically the southern end of the application route was in the parish of Bishop's Caundle.
