

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic from Point A (at approximately SY 6702 9820) by the church at the northern end of definitive bridleway S 32/5, northwards to Point B (at approximately SY 6705 9827) at the end of the public road near Nether Cerne Farms and extending eastwards and south-eastwards to Point C (at approximately SY 6788 9831) at the public road in the parish of Nether Cerne to be shown as a Byway Open to All Traffic.
