Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic for a route from Point A (at approximately ST 9309 9559) at the corner of the public road, northwards to Point B (at approximately ST 9308 9560) at the eastern end of definitive footpath SE 17/11, and continuing northwards to Point C (at approximately ST 9316 9589) at the southern end of definitive footpath SE 17/15, then eastwards to Point D (at approximately ST 9336 9585) at the western end of the public road known as Peatons Lane, all in the Parish of Lytchett Matravers.
