Adding a bridleway for a route known as Stock Lane and Lanch Lane extending from Point A (at approximately ST 7854 2701) the end of the public road at Stock Farm, westwards along Stock Lane to Point B (at approximately ST 7706 2659) at the junction with Lanch Lane and definitive bridleway N 64/62, and southwards along Lanch Lane to Point C (at approximately ST 7718 2626) on the public road, Langham Lane, and continuing southwards to Point D (at approximately ST 7724 2604) on the public road at Langham, all in the parish of Gillingham.
