Adding a byway open to all traffic for a route known as Blind Lane, from Point A (at approximately ST 4189 0395) on the public road between Drimpton and Burstock, curving south eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 4213 0394) at the end of definitive bridleway W 23/69, and on to Point C (at approximately ST 4230 0370) at the corner in the public road near the reservoir in the Parish of Burstock.
