I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic for a route known as Drew's Lane and Shipley Lane, extending from Point A (at approximately ST 7363 1847) at the end of the county road, north eastwards along Drews Lane to Point B (at approximately ST 7417 1898) at the junction of Haddon Lane and Shipney Lane, then along Shipney to Point C (at approximately ST 7433 1843) at the northern end of the county road by Gray's Farm, The route is all in Stalbridge parish. Two definitive footpaths terminate on the application route.
