Upgrading to a bridleway footpaths N62/3 and N 62/27 for the route from Point A (at approximately ST 8216 2348) on the A30, northwards along Cott Lane, definitive footpath N 62/3, to Point B (at approximately ST 8203 2380) then north eastwards to Point C (at approximately ST 8177 2393) and northwards along public footpath N 62/27 to Point D (at approximately ST 8179 2401) at the southern end of the public road by Cowslip Farm, in the parish of East Stour.
