Adding a bridleway for a route known as Stalbridge Lane, starting from Point A (at approximately ST 7793 1459) at the northern end of the public road by Colber Farm and Oaks Farm, and extending generally north-westwards to Point B (at approximately ST 7730 1541) where it joins the end of the public road which comes south-eastwards from Manor Farm, in the parish of Sturminster Newton.
