

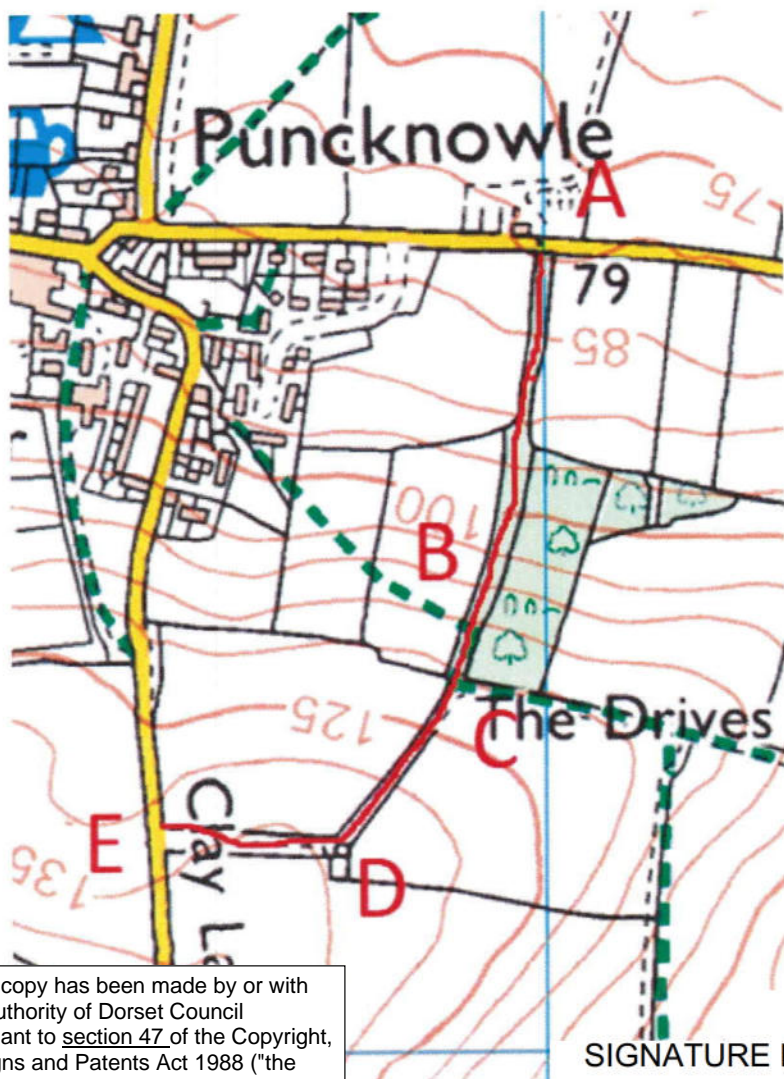
Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Dorset

Map accompanying the DMMO application to record a restricted byway along the route shown on the plan below:

The application route, all within the parish of Puncknowle, is shown on the plan below: It runs from Point A (at approximately SY 5400 8864) on the main road east of Puncknowle, southwards to Point B (at approximately SY 5394 8834) where definitive footpath W 14/11 joins from the west, continuing southwards along this footpath to Point C (at approximately SY 5393 8830) where definitive footpath leaves the application route and goes eastwards. The application route continues south-westwards to Point D (at approximately SY 5383 8817) and then turns westwards to Point E (at approximately SY 5370 8818) where it meets the public road, Clay Lane, south of Puncknowle.

5. The sections from A to B and from C to D to E are to be additions as restricted byway, and the section from B to C is for an upgrade to restricted byway.



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
