I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a bridleway along the route extending from Point A (at approximately SY 5575 9735) at the bend in the public road south west of the village of Toller Porcorum, extending east-south-eastwards to Point B (at approximately SY 5602 9721) where it crosses the stream, and on east-south-eastwards to Point C (at approximately SY 5615 9714) and on south-eastwards to Point D (at approximately SY 5621 9700) at the southern end of definitive footpath S45/11, and then continues to Point E (at approximately SY 5629 9680) at the junction of definite bridleways S 61/16 and S 45/10, in the parish of Toller Porcorum.
