Adding a byway open to all traffic along the route known as Coles Lane from Point A (at approximately ST 5867 1145) at the northern end of D20532, Cole's Lane, near the parish boundary with Ryme Intrinseca, past the footpath N34/9 to Point B (at approximately ST5895 1116), a distance of approximately 485m in the parish of Yetminster.
