Adding a byway open to all traffic along the route from Point A

From Point A (at approximately SY 7783 9928) on the public road near Dewlish Mill, eastwards to Point B (at approximately SY 7788 9929) then southwards to Point C (at approximately SY 7799 9886) at the southern end of definitive bridleway S 19/5 and continuing southwards to Point D (at approximately SY 7780 9836) on the public road in Dewlish in the parish of Dewlish to be shown as Byway Open to All Traffic.
