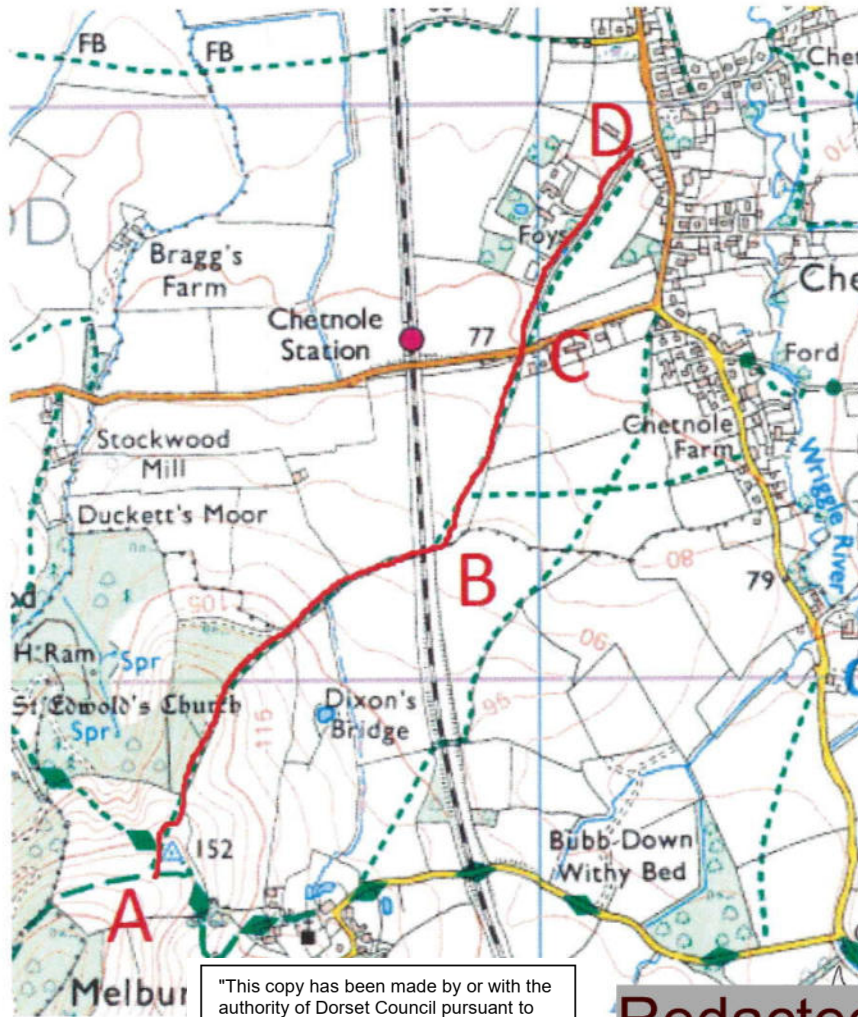


# Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

## The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Dorset

Map accompanying the DMMO application to record a brideway along the route shown on the plan below:

The route extends from Point A (at approximately ST 5929 0665) at the junction with definite brideway N 22/2, and extends north-eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 5979 0724) where it crosses the railway line at grade, continuing north-eastwards to Point C (at approximately ST 5997 0758) on the public road leading west out of Chetnole, and continues on north-eastwards past Foys to Point D (at approximately ST 6017 0792) where it joins the end of the short spur of public road in Chetnole village. The sections from Points A to B and B to C are upgrades of footpaths N 22/3 and N 9/22; the section from C to D is an addition. Note: public footpath N 9/23 is in the field alongside the application route from C to D.

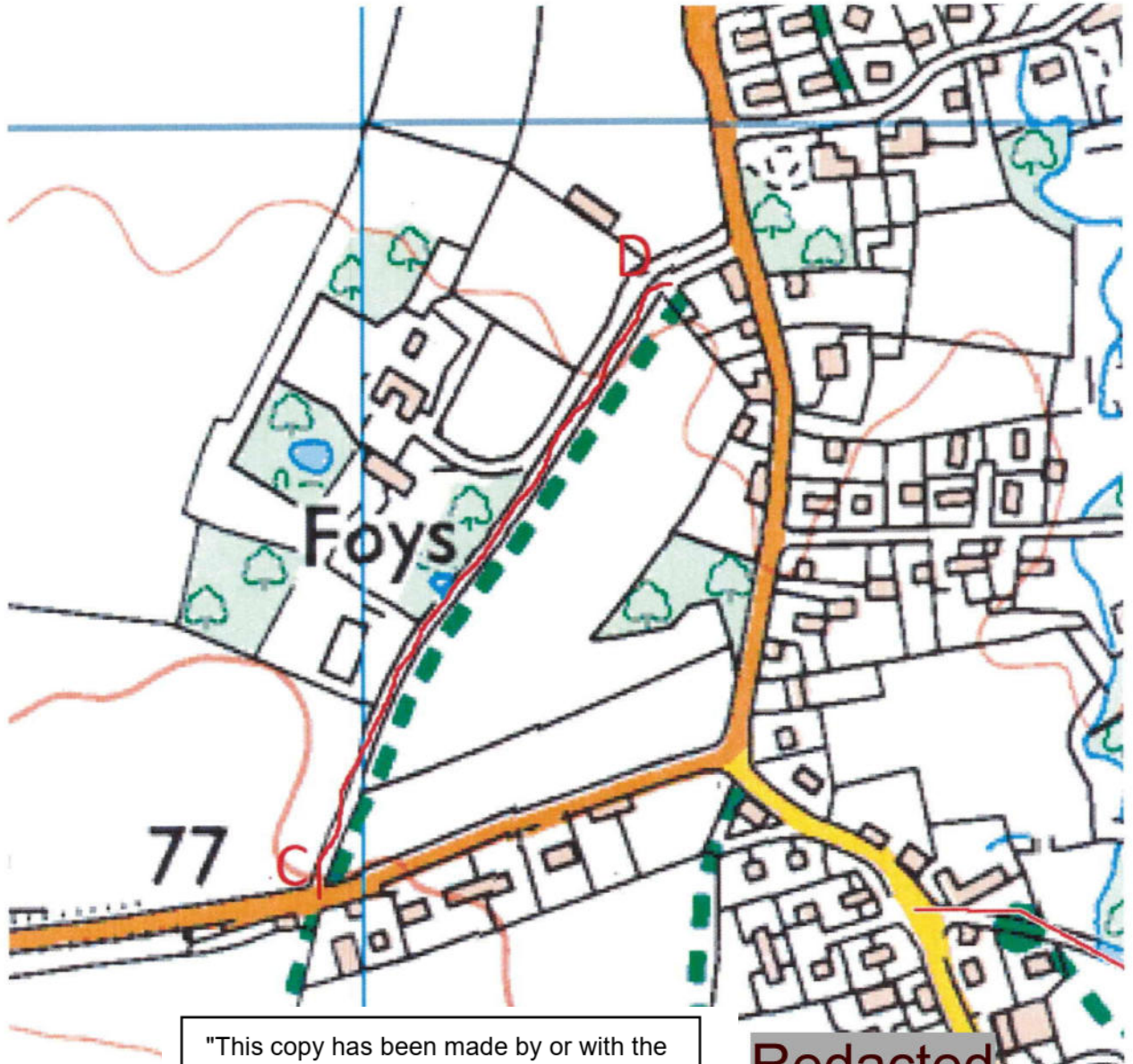


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
