I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Upgrading to a bridleway the route extending from Point A (at approximately SY 6415 9971), on the footpath S 42/6 at the northern end of the definitive bridleway, S 42/7, extending in an east-northeasterly direction past Point B (at approximately SY 6418 9972) at the northern end of definitive bridleway S 42/12, continuing on to Point C (at approximately ST 6465 0007) where it crosses the definitive bridleway S 42/5 and then across the parish boundary and on to Point D (at approximately ST 6514 0035) where it meets the public road, in the parishes of Sydling St. Nicholas and Cerne Abbas.
