Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic for a route known as Berwick Lane and Back Lane, starting from Point A (at approximately SY 5239 8962) on the public road in Berwick, along Berwick Lane southwards to Point B (at approximately SY 5246 8914) eastwards to Point C (at approximately SY 5258 8911) and southwards to Point D (at approximately SY 5259 8858) then eastwards to Point E (at approximately SY 5274 8858) and southwards along Back Lane to Point F (at approximately SY 5263 8826) on the public road in Swyre all in the parish of Swyre.
