Adding a bridleway from Point A (at approximately ST 6790 1532) on the public road by Ashcombe Farm southwards to Point B (at approximately ST 6805 1517) and south-westwards to Point C (at approximately ST 6788 1493) and southwards to Point D (at approximately ST 6791 1441) at the acute bend in the public road by Prytown Farm, in the parish of Caundle Marsh.
