
I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Recording a byway open to all traffic along the route from Point A (at approximately ST 5692 0886) on the public road near Holt Mill, westwards to Point B (at approximately ST 5673 0084), upgrading to a bridleway part of the definitive footpath W 33/17 from Point B (at approximately ST 5673 0084) west-north-westwards to Point C (at approximately ST 5653 0889), and adding a bridleway from Point C (at approximately ST 5653 0889) and continuing south-westwards to Point D (at approximately ST 5648 0877), then westwards to Point E (at approximately ST 5637 0880) and southwards to Point F (at approximately ST 5633 0858) and westwards to Point G (at approximately ST 5625 0857) and southwards to Point H (at approximately ST 5623 0802), then eastwards through Point I (at approximately ST 5642 0798), and Point J (at approximately ST 5645 0794) to Point K (at approximately ST 5666 0793), then northwards to Point L (at approximately ST 5666 0802) and eastwards to Point M (at approximately ST 5718 0815) where it joins the public road, all in the parish of Melbury Osmond.
