I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a bridleway from Point A (at approximately ST 6679 1236) on the public road, Down Lane, extending east-south-eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 6700 1227) where it joins definitive footpath N 11/19. and upgrading to a bridleway the section of definitive footpath N 11/19 from Point B (at approximately ST 67001227) south-eastwards along the line of definitive footpath to Point C (at approximately ST 6706 1225) on the public road near Bishop's Down. The route from Point A to Point B is for an addition of a bridleway, and the section from Point B to Point C is for an upgrade to bridleway. The route is all in the parish of Folke.
