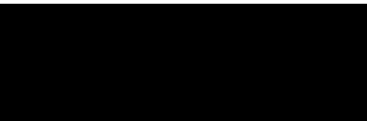

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic from Point A (at approximately SY 5022 9793) at the eastern end of the public road at Loscombe, Powerstock, extending eastwards and north-eastwards to Point B (at approximately SY 5154 9844) at the western end of definitive bridleway W 37/11, and on to Point C (at approximately SY 5198 9836) on the public road north east of Manor Farm in North Poorton, in the Parishes of Powerstock and North Poorton.
