## The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Dorset

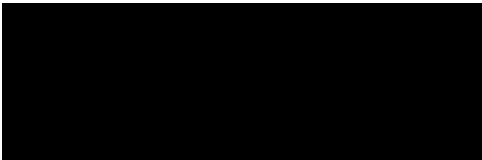

I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a byway open to all traffic from Point A (at approximately ST 8801 0123) at the junction of the public bridleways E 17/18, E 17/19 and E17/26 on Charlton Down, north eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 8941 0222), at the south eastern end of definitive bridleway E 17/22 and the end of the public road at North Farm all in the Parish of Spetisbury We note that the Dorset Explorer website shows the public road extending to Point B, whereas the OS map shows the public road stopping a short distance further northeast to approximately ST 8949 0228.
