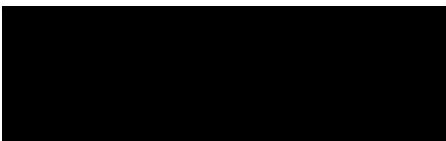

I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, DowlishWake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic for a route starting at Point A (at approximately ST 9352 1415) at the eastern end of the definitive bridleway E 20/12 on the parish boundary between Tarrant Gunville and Chettle, and extending eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 9428 1426), past New Barn where the route is crossed by definitive bridleway E 7/5, and continuing eastwards to Point C (at approximately ST 9466 1434) on the county road, Dunspit Lane, all in the parish of Chettle.
