For a route in the parish of Shipton Gorge, extending from Point A (at approximately SY 4865 9155) at the eastern end of definitive bridleway W 15/22, eastwards to Point B (at approximately SY 4889 9159) at the northern end of Milvers Way, and continuing on eastwards to Point C (at approximately SY 4909 9168) at the south eastern end of definitive footpath W 15/23, and continuing on to Point D (at approximately SY 4944 9153) at the north eastern end of definitive footpath W 15/21, then on to Point E (at approximately SY 4957 9152) at the junction of roads at the western end of Shipton Gorge to be shown as Byway Open to All Traffic.
