Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route known as Milvers Way in the manor of Shipton Gorge in the parish of Burton Bradstock, extending from Point A (at approximately SY 4884 9081) near the junction of definitive bridleways W 7/22 and W 7/23 at the northern end of the public road south west of Shipton Gorge, and extending in a northerly direction to Point B (at approximately SY 4889 9159) at the junction with Burpitt Lane.
