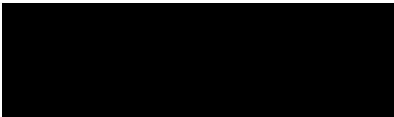
I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic for a route in the parish of Cranborne. The application route extends from Point A (at approximately SU 0545 1751) at the end of the public vehicular road north of Blagdon Farm, northwards to Point B (at approximately SU 0545 1772) at the south western corner of the wood, and continues northwards to Point C (at approximately SU 0533 1800) on the parish boundary with Pentridge and the junction with definitive bridleways E 52/45, E 52/44 and E 52/48 in the parish of Cranborne.
