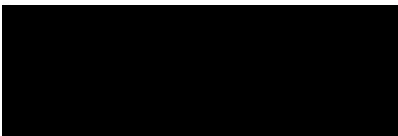

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic in the parish of Tarrant Hinton, extending from Point A (at approximately ST 9344 1206) at the end of the public road by Eastbury Farm, north-eastwards and eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 9400 1233) at the junction of the ends of restricted byway E 21/7, definitive footpath E 21/8 and definitive bridleway E 21/5, all in the parish of Tarrant Hinton.
