Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route in the parish of Tarrant Hinton from Point A (at approximately ST 9241 1154) at the junction of definitive bridleways E 21/13 and E 21/15, extending north-eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 9301 1184) where the definitive footpath E 21/2 joins the route, and continues onwards to Point C (at approximately ST 9313 1194) on the parish boundary at the public road.
