

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route known as Drive Lane in the parish of Batcombe from Point A (at approximately ST 6186 0438) on the public road, Stile Lane, eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 6214 0440) at the north eastern end of definitive footpath N 3/2 and then north eastwards to Point C (at approximately ST 6225 0465) on the public road at Great Head.
