I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route known as Green Lane from Point A (at approximately SY 4806 9324) on the public road on the east side Bridport in the parish of Bradpole, extending north east to the parish boundary with Loders at Point B (at approximately SY 4862 9336).

Adding a bridleway from Point B (at approximately SY 4862 9336) extending eastwards to Point C (at approximately SY 4879 9338) where it is joined by a route from the south which is the subject of another DMMO application, the application route then continues north eastward to Point D (at approximately SY 4885 9346) at the southern end of definitive bridleway W 13/29, and continues north-eastwards to Point E (at approximately SY 4914 9369) where the application route becomes a track, known as Bar Lane. This section of the application route is in the parish of Loders.

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic from Point E (at approximately SY 4914 9369) along Bar Lane north-eastwards to Point F (at approximately SY 4960 9397) on the public road in Yonderover in the parish of Loders.

The application is for the section from A to B in Bradpole parish to be recorded as a Byway Open to All Traffic, the section from B to C to D to E in Loders parish to be recorded as a bridleway, and the section from E to F to be recorded as Byway Open to All Traffic.
