

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic from Point A (at approximately ST 6028 1372) at the end of the public road in Thornford, extending northwards along Bembury Lane to Point B (at approximately ST 6032 1381) at the southern end of definitive bridleway N 32/15, in Thornford to be shown as a Byway Open to All Traffic.
