

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route extending from the bend in the public road by Sturminster Common at Point A (at approximately ST 7880 1245), southwards to Point B (at approximately ST 7886 1221) where it meets the definitive bridleway N 53/26, in the parish of Sturminster Newton.
