Upgrading to a bridleway the section of footpath W 24/5 which runs from Point A (at approximately ST 4355 0251) on the public road (B 3164) and extends southwards along definitive footpath across Hursey common to Point B (at approximately ST 4354 0240).


Add a bridleway from Point B (at approximately ST 4354 0240) over the common to Point C (at approximately ST 4351 0234) and then along the lane known as Stockham Lane to Point D (at approximately ST 4288 0192) on the public road (the B 3164).

The application route is all within the parish of Burstock.
