

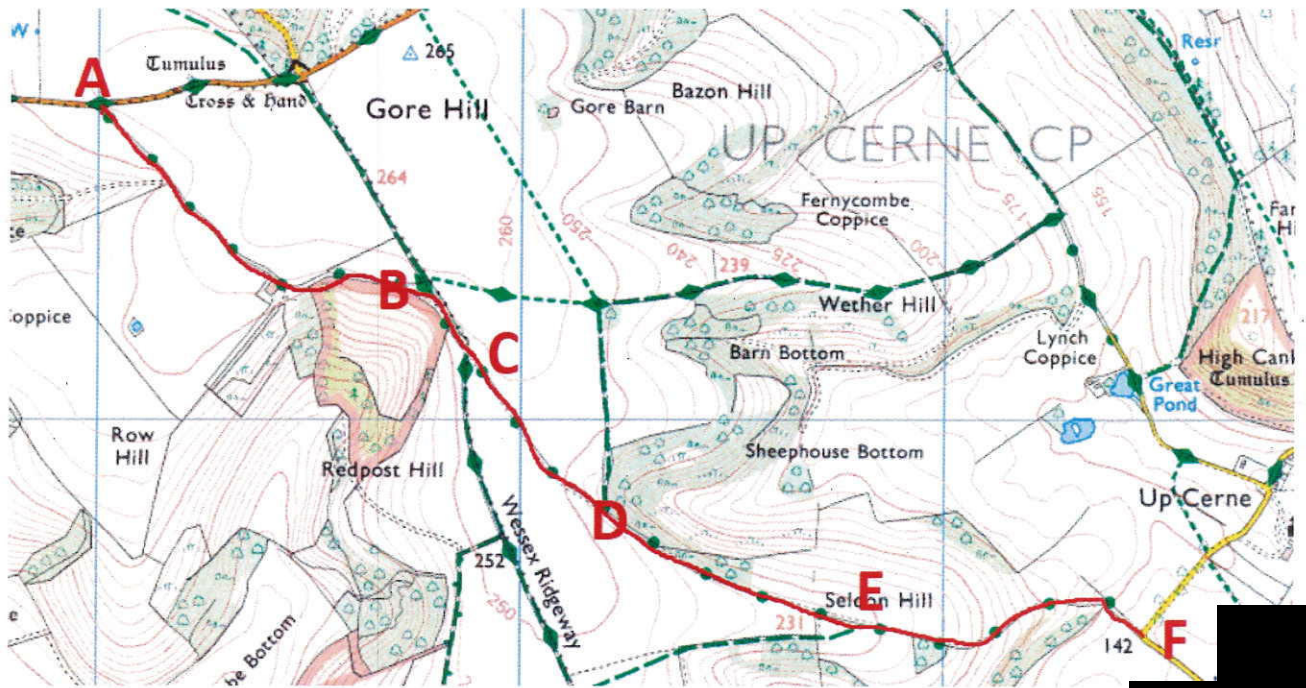
Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Dorset

Map accompanying the DMMO application to:-

Add a bridleway along a route in the parishes of Sydling St Nicholas and Up Cerne starting from Point A (at approximately ST6300 0375) on the public road and the Batcombe and Sydling St. Nicholas parish boundary, and extending south-eastwards and eastwards around the northern side of Redpost Hill to Point B (at approximately ST 6378 0329) at the southern end of definite bridleway S 42/30 and then continuing south-eastwards to Point C (at approximately ST6388 0317) at the northern end of definitive bridleway S 42/05, and then south eastwards to Point D (at approximately ST 6419 0280) at the southern end of definitive bridleway S 47/07 and then south-eastwards around the northern side of Seddon Hill to Point E (at approximately St 6485 0251) at the north-eastern end of definitive bridleway S 47/02 and then south eastwards to Point F (at approximately ST 6546 0250) at corner in the public road.

The section of the route between Points A to B to C is in the parish of Sydling St. Nicholas, and the section from Points C to D to E to F are in the parish of Up Cerne.



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
