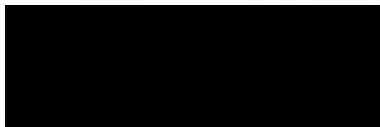

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic for a route in Bourton from Point A (at approximately ST 7557 2945) on the public road, the B 3081, extending northwards to Point B (at approximately ST 7561 2981), then eastwards to Point C (at approximately ST 7587 2993) and continues south eastwards to Point D (at approximately ST 7658 2926) at the public road in West Bourton. This application route is in the parish of Bourton.
