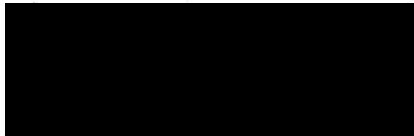

Adding a bridleway along a route starting from Point A (at approximately ST 6268 0143) on the bend in the public road near Up Sydling House and extending northwards to Point B (at approximately ST 6266 0158) and north-eastwards to Point C (at approximately ST 6269 0160) at the south eastern end of definitive bridleway S42/26, in the parish of Sydling St. Nicholas.
