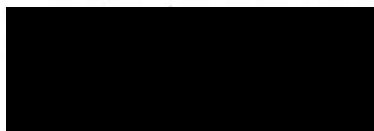

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route extending from Point A (at approximately SU 0330 1766) at the eastern end of definitive bridleway E 52/53 and the end of the public road near the church in Pentridge, southwards to Point B (at approximately SU 0322 1720) at the junction of definitive bridleways E 57/23 and E 57/32 on the parish boundary with Wimborne St. Giles to be shown as Byway Open to All Traffic, The application route is all in the parish of Pentridge.
