on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of
the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for
the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route known as Wraxall Lane from Point A (at approximately ST 5762 0079) on the public road in Lower Wraxall, south-eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 5844 0021) at the southern end of the spur going northwards. Wraxall Lane continues on to Point D (at approximately SY 5864 9940) at the end of the spur of public road by Grove Stall Farm in Chilfrome. This application also includes the spur from Point B (at approximately 5844 0021) northwards to Point C (at approximately ST 5850 0046) on the public road in Wraxall. These connecting routes are in the parishes of Wraxall and Chilfrome. The application is to add both routes to the Definitive map as Byway Open to All Traffic.
