Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic for a route in the parish of Sturminster Marshall from Point A (at approximately SY 9035 9900) at the end of the public road near Mapperton Farm, extending north-northwestwards past Point B (at approximately SY 8957 9979) at the eastern end of definitive bridleway E53/21 and continuing to Point C (at approximately ST 8933 0039) on the parish boundary with Spetisbury and the southern end of definitive bridleway E 17/18.
