the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for
the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic for a route in the parish of Askerswell from Point A
(at approximately SY 5445 9393) on the public road opposite the eastern end of definitive
bridleway W 4/3 eastwards to Point B (at approximately SY 5485 9394) at the northern
end of definitive bridleway W4/4 on the parish boundary between Askerswell and Litton
Cheney and continuing on to Point C (at approximately SY 5520 9383) on the public
road at Two Gates to be shown as a Byway Open to All Traffic.
