I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a bridleway for a route known as Coney Lane in the parish of Hazelbury Bryan from Point A (at approximately ST 7426 0845) on the public road at the north end of Hazelbury Bryan, eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 7454 0845) where two definitive footpaths (N 41/16 and N 41/18) meet on the route, and then continuing eastwards to Point C (at approximately ST 7482 0869) on the public road between the war memorial and Manor Farm, all in the parish of Hazelbury Bryan.
