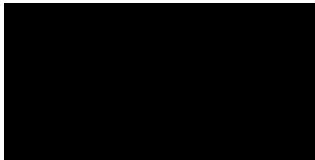
I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route known as Ridgeway Lane and Common Drove extending from Point A (at approximately ST 8299 1331) on the public road at Gold Hill, north-eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 8353 1391) at the south western end of definitive bridleway N 35/04, and then south-eastwards along Common Drove to Point C (at approximately ST 8397 1349) on the public road, Sandy Lane, on the north east side of Child Okeford. The route is all within the parish of Child Okeford.
