the area by:-

Adding a bridleway for a route in the parish of Powerstock from Point A (at
approximately SY 5239 9525) at the public road at Marsh Farm, extending north east to
Point B (at approximately SY 5283 9559) at the eastern end of public footpath W 39/30,
then to eastwards to Point C (at approximately SY 5313 9553) at the western end of
public footpath W 39/27, then south eastwards to Point D (at approximately SY 5360
9523) where it joins the public road.
