I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic from Point A (at approximately ST 9548 0041) on the public road coming eastwards from Sturminster Marshall, extending in a southerly direction to Point B (at approximately SY 9593 9962) and eastwards to Point C (at approximately SY 9560 9943).

Upgrading to a Byway Open to All Traffic the section of definitive footpath E 53/3 from Point C (at approximately SY 9560 9943) northwards to Point D (at approximately SY 9555 9949).

Upgrading to a Byway Open to All Traffic the section of definitive footpath E 53/3 from Point D (at approximately SY 9555 9949) westwards along a section of definitive footpath E 53/3 to Point E (at approximately SY 9541 9944).

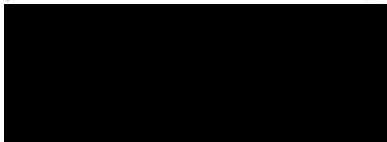
Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic from Point E (at approximately SY 9541 9944) north-westwards to Point F (at approximately SY 9492 9968) on the public roads coming southwards from Sturminster Marshall.

The sections from A to B to C are for additions to the definitive map, and the sections from C to D to E are to upgrade sections of definitive footpaths E 53/3, and the section from E to F is for an addition, all to the status of Byway Open to All Traffic. Parts of the route is adopted road D40704
