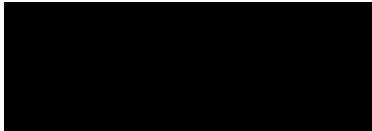

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route from Point A (at approximately SY 8019 9738) on the public road in Milborne St. Andrew, southwards to Point B (at approximately SY 8019 9727) and eastwards past Points C (at approximately SY 8034 9724) and Point D (at approximately SY 8037 9725) to Point E (at approximately SY 8046 9727) on the public road. The route is in the parish of Milborne St. Andrew and the eastern section was formerly in the parish of Bere Regis.
