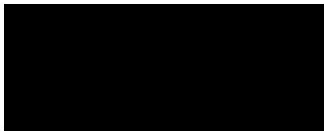
I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route known as Back Lane extending from Point A (at approximately SY 6022 9641) at the eastern end of the public road and the eastern end of definitive footpath S 29/21 southwards to Point B (at approximately SY 6023 9638) at the eastern end of definitive footpath S 29/19 to Point C (at approximately SY 6089 9584) at the corner in definitive bridleway S 29/17 by Notton Farm to be shown as a Byway Open to All Traffic. The application route is all in the parish of Maiden Newton.
