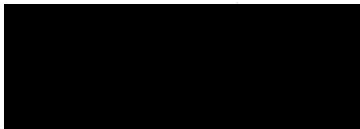

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route known as Pound Wood Lane from Point A (at approximately SY 9010 9556) at the corner of the public road by West Morden Farm and extending north westwards to Point B (at approximately SY 8994 9576) at the junction of bridleways SE 19/15 and SE 19/16 to be shown as a Byway Open to All Traffic. The application route is all in the parish of Morden.
