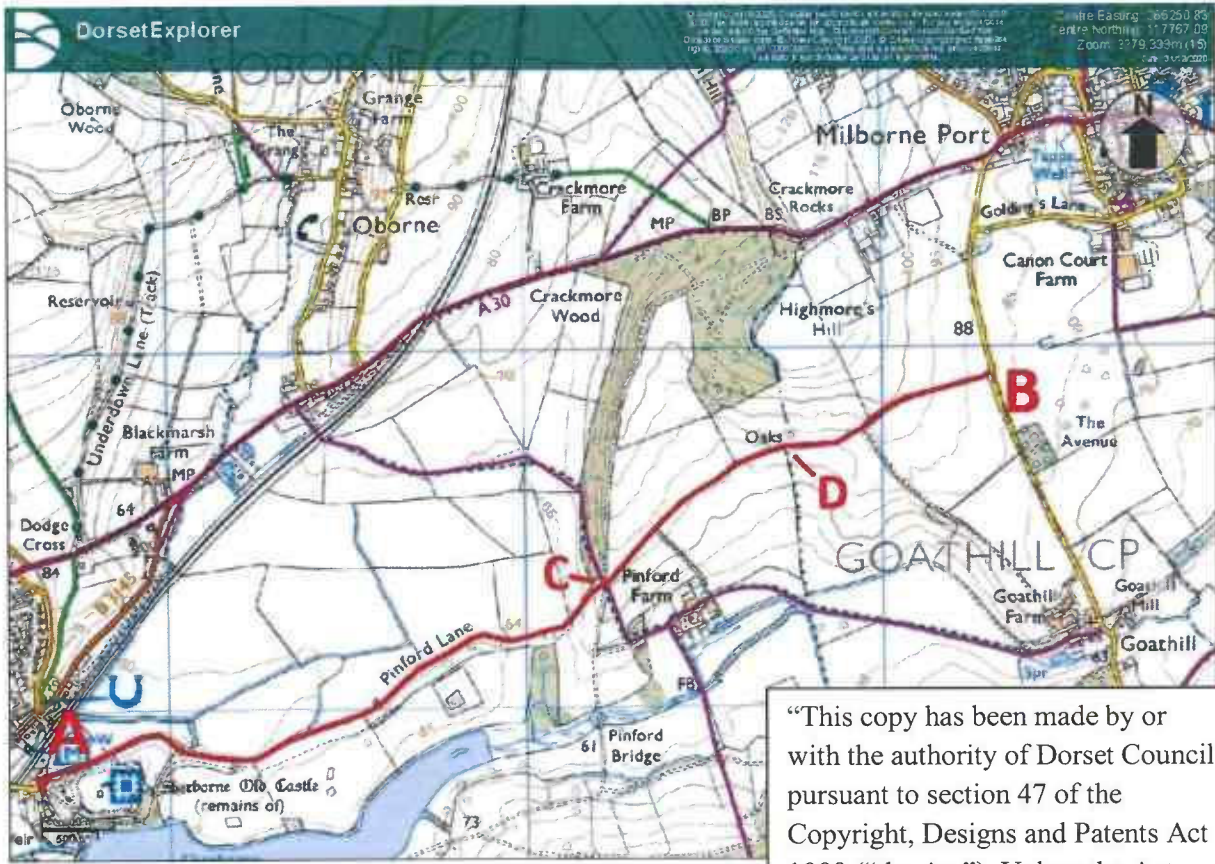


Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

The Definitive Map and Statemen of Rights of Way in Dorset

Map accompanying the DMMO application to add a bridleway along the route shown on the plan below. The route runs from Point A (at approximately ST6464 1678) at the end of D20208 Castleton Road close to St Mary Magdalen Church, Castleton firstly for approximately 30 m northwards, and then generally east north eastwards along the route known as Pinford Lane, crossing the public footpath N7/4 near Pinford Farm at point C (at approximately ST 6623 1735) to the Castleton – Goathill parish boundary at point D (at approximately ST 6675 1772), then running along the parish and county boundary to Point B (at approximately ST6731 1792) at the junction with C72 Goathill Road, a distance of approximately 3077 meters, in the civil parishes of Castleton and Goathill in the County of Dorset, with the northern side of a short section of the application route in the civil parish of Milborne Port in the County of Somerset.
