

I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along a route known as Dyers Farm Road extending from Point A (at approximately ST 6126 0483) at the eastern end of the Byway Open to All Traffic, N3/18, north-eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 6132 0489) at the eastern end of definitive footpath N 3/17, and continuing eastwards past Dyer's Farm to Point C (at approximately ST 6153 0490) on the public road in Pleck, in the parish of Batcombe.
